Weekly Study Guide

Pood Evadus 20:12 and Matthew Ev21 22 In what ways does anger "kill"?
Read Exodus 20:13 and Matthew 5:21-22. In what ways does anger "kill"?
Read Exodus 20:14 and Matthew 5:27-28. How do you define adultery? Why would Jesus equate a thought (lust) with an act (adultery)? Can pain or hurt result from a thought? Why or why not?
Read Exodus 20:15 and Matthew 25:40-42. What does the Matthew passage reveal about Jesus' thoughts about stealing?
Read Exodus 20:16 and John 1:14. John uses the word "truth" 14 times in his gospel! Why is "truth" so important? Have you ever been hurt by a lie? Is there someone to whom you owe the truthshared in love?
Read Exodus 20:17. "Covet" simply means "to desire strongly". What is the difference between "admire" and "covet"? Have you ever disliked or wished bad things on someone who had something you wanted? Take a moment and thank God for everything you <u>do</u> have!

Daily Prayer: Lord Jesus, thank you for being in relationship with me despite my behavior. Help me be mindful of and eliminate behaviors that are inconsistent with your command to love others as you love me. Amen.
