
Weekly Study Guide



Why are memories important to you?
Look around your home and note the items in full display that cause you to remember.
Why do you think "remember" is such a prominent theme in Scripture?
Read Luke 22:14-20. You will notice Luke mentions two cups. There are various explanations for this, all grounded in the fact that multiple cups (four, in fact) are used symbolically throughout the Passover meal.
In verse 14, Jesus says he has "eagerly" or "earnestly" desired to eat this meal with his apostles. Why would that be?

What is the very first thing Jesus does with the cup and the breadand why?
As you consider your personal experience with Holy Communion, has it been meaningful? boring? somewhere in between? What, if anything, makes Holy Communion special for you?
Holy Communion is one way of remembering that God loves you. Describe 2-3 other ways God reminds you that he loves you.
Daily Prayer: Lord, thank you for memories. Help me to remember just how much you

love me. Amen.


