Weekly Study Guide

Something to Think About: Have you every volunteered for something for which you felt totally unqualified, given money to a cause when you felt like you couldn't afford to do so, or volunteered your time when you felt like you had no time to give? If so, then you already know what an experience like that can do for your faith. That's the way personal ministry works. God says, "You do what you know how to do and leave the rest to me!"

How have you traditionally responded when asked to serve the church or any other faith-based organization? When have you said "yes", and when have you said "no"? Explain your reasons.
How have you traditionally responded when asked to make a financial gift to a worthy cause? When have you said "yes", and when have you said "no' Explain your reasons.
Has God ever helped you do something that, otherwise, you could not hav done on your own? Explain. What did this experience do to your faith?

Read Matthew 14:13-21. The disciples used the size of the crowd, the time of day, and the lack of food as excuses not to do what Jesus asked them to do. Have you ever used excuses when asked to do something for God?
Read Matthew 14:22-33. Some see this story as being about Peter's lack of faith. He took his eyes off of Jesus and started to sink. Others see it as an example of Peter's robust faith. He was the only one who actually stepped out of the boat. Which way do you read the storyand why?
What might God be asking you to do that makes you feel uncomfortable, incapable or uncertain? What <u>can</u> you dowhile trusting God to do the rest?

Daily Prayer: God, give me faith to do what I can do and leave the rest up to you. Amen.
