Something to Think About: For way too many of us, it's hard to find and hold onto joy, especially in the Christmas season. Sad memories, loneliness, being away from our loved ones...and now, we're all dealing with COVID. Ugh! Where's the joy? When the angel proclaimed the "good news" of Jesus' birth. It was <u>really</u> good news. It was good then; it's good today, despite your life's circumstances. In Joseph's story, there is some really good news for you. It's the fact that, no matter how you've behaved or what you believe or what may be going on in your life, <u>God is with you</u>...this Christmas season and every season of the year.


