Study Guide

Something to Think About: Every day you are writing a story. It's the story of your life. It's a story only you can write. It's a story you are constantly sharing with others, and it's a story others will share about you for generations to come. As you look ahead into the new year, what needs to change about the story you are writing? What is it you know you should do this year that continues to be on the list labeled "*Maybe Later*"?

Do you make New Year's resolutions? If so, how well do you typically keep them?

What is one thing that you need to focus on this year? Perhaps it's one of these:

- A habit you must break
- A project you must finish
- A relationship you must rebuild or retire
- A debt you must pay off
- A spiritual practice you must start

Read **Nehemiah 1:1-4**. Nehemiah is heartbroken because of what's happening in his homeland. He was moved to action. When is the last time you've been moved to action?

Read **Nehemiah 2:1-10.** Notice the many ways King Artaxerxes seeks to satisfy his servant's requests. This was unheard of in the ancient world. What do you think prompted the King's eagerness to help his servant? (Hint: see verse 8.)

Read **Nehemiah 2:11-20** as Nehemiah motivates a team to rebuild the wall. Notice also the naysayers' responses (versed 19-20). How did Nehemiah respond when he was mocked and ridiculed? Has this ever happened to you? If so, how did you respond?

Read **Nehemiah chapters 4 and 6**. Record the various ways Nehemiah's enemies attempted to thwart his efforts to rebuild the wall.

Read **Nehemiah 6:1-5**. Nehemiah responded to his enemies the same way...<u>six</u> times! What was that response?

Read **Nehemiah 6:15-16**. The wall was completed, and Nehemiah's enemies *"were afraid and lost their confidence"*. Why?

Daily Prayer: God, help me see the one thing I need to change in my life. Give me the passion, courage, discipline and persistence of Nehemiah to get it done. Amen.




