The Power of Perseverance

James 1:1-6





Study Guide

Something to Think About: What do you do when life changes and there's nothing you can do to change it back? What do you do when there's nothing you can do? What do you do when the only question left to ask is, "Now what?" James, the brother of Jesus, suggests we should find joy in our trials and that we should be patient while perseverance finishes its work. Really!? This sounds more like a pep talk than it does practical advice. But what if it's true? What if it's possible?

Do you tend to be patient or impatient? How does that tendency affect your relationships and the way you deal with your circumstances?
How do you usually handle sudden changes in your life? Do you go with the flow or does the unexpected stress you out?
Define "perseverance". When have you most needed perseverance in your life? Did you find it? If so, how?
Read James 1:1-6 . Do you think it's realistic to be able to consider your trials as "pure joy"? Why or why not?

Has adversity ever "tested your faith" (verse 3) as James suggests? If so, in what way?
James also suggests we allow "perseverance to finish it work" (verse 4). Is perseverance an event or a process? Explain your answer.
Notice the reference to being "pure and complete, not lacking in anything" (verse 4). Describe what that would look like in your life.
Read verse 5 carefully and in its context. What does James suggest we pray for when we face trials, and why is he so confident that God will actually give it to us?
<u>Daily Prayer</u> : God, give me wisdom, patience, and strength to allow perseverance to finish its work amid my most difficult circumstances. Amen.
