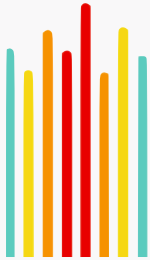

A Word From Pastor Jim



The fact is that our views about God, our personal theologies, and our ideas about the Bible have been largely shaped by the views, theologies, and ideas of other people. What if “other people” had it wrong? What if “other people” either minimized or didn’t understand the main message of the Gospel—that if you put your trust in Jesus, God is OK with you. And since God is OK with you, God’s highest desire is for you to be OK with other people. What if we just got that one thing right?

Paul writes, "The only thing that counts is [your] faith expressing itself through love" (Gal 5:6b). Do you think love really is the only thing that counts in God's eyes, or are there other things?

Reflect and react to this statement: Since Jesus died for me, it stands to reason that Jesus is always for me.

Reflect and react to the Apostle Paul's statement: But God demonstrates his own love for us in this: While we were still sinners, Christ died for us ([Rom 5:8](#)).

Daily Prayer: God, help me to know that you are OK with me so that I am able to focus relentlessly on being OK with other people. Amen.

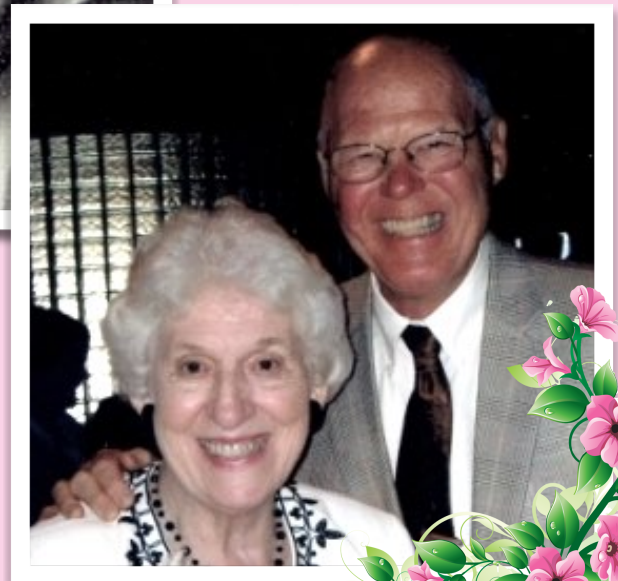

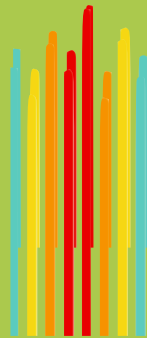
