This Sunday, I will be preaching on Mark 6:35-44 and my title will be "The Economy of Jesus."

When you read the Gospels, you quickly notice that Jesus simply did not look at the world or life the way most people do. Like I pointed out last week, most of us would see a needy,

demanding crowd of people and want to run the other way, but Jesus saw them and had compassion for them. In this week's lesson, Jesus had a hungry crowd with a tiny portion of food, and he saw the opportunity to have a grand picnic. The disciples evaluated the situation the way most people would: there wasn't enough. Jesus thought differently.

How many times in our lives have we misjudged a situation or missed an opportunity? God is the God of abundance, not the god of scarcity. We frequently do not see things that way.

Please pray for me as I prepare and deliver this message. I am praying for each one of you.




