This Sunday I will be preaching on Isaiah 55:1-9 and my title will be "The Candy Bar Diet."

body shaming, and body positivity. Additionally, we are flooded with ads about food and drinks so delicious they will (supposedly) change your life.

This passage from Isaiah is about food but not the kind of food we usually discuss. So this week I will talk about food and NOT talk about food simultaneously. Isaiah gets the reader's attention by talking about food, a subject that interests everyone. Yet he is actually talking about spiritual food, what God provides.






