Dear Friends,

This Sunday I will be preaching on Mark 7:24-30 and my title will be "The Dog Who Talked Back to Jesus."

Name calling is rude and offensive, so it's surprising and disturbing when we read Jesus's words in these verses. He compared the Gentile woman to a dog,

saying that the children's food (his attention and healing work) should not be given to dogs (Gentiles). He was clarifying that his ministry was focused on the Jewish people first. Also, "dog" was a common racial slur used by Jews to describe non-Jews (Gentiles).

This woman did not give up, but she didn't take offense or argue with Jesus about his insult. She accepted his answer but used his analogy to come up with a logical conclusion. She wasn't asking to be his top priority, she merely wanted the "scraps" from his "table." Jesus rewarded her by healing her daughter.

We especially thank Wayne and Judy Harris who spent much of last Saturday working to ensure


the benches were securely installed.


