#### **Reflections From Pastor Tom**



Dear Friends,

This Sunday, I will be preaching on John 2:1-11 and the title will be "Ordinary Miracles."

We call something a miracle or miraculous when it seemingly defies the laws of nature. We believe that God works miracles because we believe God is able to

work within and beyond these natural "rules." It's important to remember that God is at work all the time, not just in the showstopping, amazing events we call miracles.

In the story from John 2, Jesus performed a miracle: he turned water into wine. Yet this wasn't a life or death situation like raising Lazarus from the dead, and it wasn't even healing that improved someone's quality of life. We might call this a "minor" miracle, but it was still significant because it was an identifying event for who Jesus was and what he was able to do.

Similarly for us, we can experience what some people might consider "minor" or insignificant, but if it makes an impact on our life or someone else's life, it still matters!




