Reflections From Pastor Tom



Dear Friends,

This Sunday I will be preaching on John 12:1-8 and my title will be "Servants and Thieves."

Mary, Martha, and Lazarus were close friends with Jesus. In what would be the last few days before his arrest and crucifixion, Jesus visited with these friends.

Mary did something dramatic - she anointed Jesus' feet with an expensive perfume, and she used her hair to clean his feet. This was, as it sounds, a remarkably humble act. It was the kind of service that would have been performed by someone of lower status in society. Supposedly Mary was of equal status to Jesus, so her doing this would have been borderline scandalous.

Within the same short scene, Judas made an objection. He saw what Mary had done and stated that the perfume should have been sold and the money given to the poor. His comment is in striking contrast to what Mary did. In parenthetical notes, John tells us that Judas was about to betray Jesus and that he was a thief, frequently stealing from the "common purse," and that he actually didn't care about the poor.

Here we have two different people with intimate access to Jesus, and two drastically different ways to handle that access. Both of them were trusted by Jesus. Mary used that trust to humble herself



before him and honor him. Judas used that trust to steal from him (and the other Disciples) and ultimately betray him.

NOTE: During the season of Lent, flowers normally placed on the altar will be located in the entrance lobby.




A Note From St. Andrew's UMC
