Dear Friends, This Sunday I will be preaching on Matthew 22:15-22 and my title will be "The Lost Art Of Loyalty."

What does "loyalty" mean these days? We try to be loyal to our friends and our family. That means we will stand UP FOR them, and stand WITH them no matter what happens. Jesus's disciples claimed they would be loyal to him, but when he was arrested, they all scattered

and ran away. Sometimes it's difficult to be LOYAL to one person or group without being DIS-LOYAL to another person or group. Sometimes it is unfair for a friend to demand loyalty when what they are asking of you requires you to betray your loyalty to another person.

Jesus was tested with the question about paying taxes. He responded by saying "Give to Caesar the things that are Caesar's and to God the things that are God's." He stumped his critics with that response because it puts the responsibility back on them to determine the proper loyalty. That's what we will talk about on Sunday.


