Communication is so important in relationships. It has often been said that in friendships, in marriage, and in work relationships, we have to communicate clearly what we want from other people.

Healthy relationships include honest, straightforward communication. That's easy to say but not always easy to do.

Jesus told a story about a master and three servants. The master trusted these servants with certain responsibilities. One of them clearly did not have a healthy relationship with the master. He was scared of him and it affected how he carried out his responsibilities. On Sunday, we will talk about how God is like (and unlike) the master in the story. We will talk about what God wants from us.


