Need."

We like to think of Jesus as strong, healthy and dominant. We like this image of him because we want him to be able to take on all of our struggles and problems along with all of the world's problems. Yet in this week's Scripture lesson, we are given a very

different picture of Jesus - hungry, thirsty, naked, sick, and imprisoned. Jesus wanted his followers to know this image of him so they would see him when they saw the people around them suffering.

Jesus was a different kind of king, a different kind of leader, and a different kind of Savior. He is that for us, today. We have to be careful how we imagine Jesus because many of the images we may want to associate with him are flawed or too limiting. Jesus is in need because all of those around us who are hurting ARE Jesus.


