

### **Reflections From Pastor Tom**



Dear Friends, This Sunday, I will be preaching on Matthew 16:21-28 and my title will be "Giving Your Life to Jesus."

I mentioned in the last Lesson from the Land the context for Jesus asking the disciples "Who do you say that I am?" in Caesarea Philippi. This week's Scripture immediately follows that conversation.

Peter had correctly stated that Jesus is the Messiah, but he only gets partial credit on the larger "exam." Jesus proceeded to explain the suffering he would have to go through and Peter objected - he "took him aside and began to rebuke him." Peter didn't fully understand what being the Messiah meant.

The disciples had given up so much to follow Jesus. They HAD denied themselves in order to be his companions on the journey. What Jesus was talking about was more than that. He was referring to the ultimate sacrifice. We will talk about that on Sunday.


