to know about other people's business." Maybe that's true, but you have to admit, many people are nosy. Social media has probably contributed significantly to the problem.

In Jesus's parable for this week, some of the workers are worried about other people's business. Specifically, they don't like that the landowner paid everyone the same amount, even though some worked only one hour and others worked the whole day. If the workers had kept their minds only on their own business, there wouldn't have been an argument. What is Jesus trying to teach us with this parable? We will talk about that on Sunday.


