Dear Friends,

This Sunday is World Communion Sunday. We will also have a special Children's Time in worship. I will be preaching on Job 2:1-6 and my title will be "The Human Dilemma."

Job is one of the most well-known books in the Bible. It's a simple story, really. A righteous man was subjected to unbelievable suffering, first to all

he owns, then to those he loves, and finally to him personally. He was tempted to curse God, but he fought against that temptation. Eventually, he received direct contact with God and restoration of what he lost (as much as it was possible).

There are many people right now feeling a bit like Job. Hurricane Helene has robbed many people of possessions, shelter, access to food, and clean water. Others died as a result of this horrible disaster. Inevitably, at a time of great tragedy, we ask the question Job asked -"Why?" I don't pretend that I can answer that question but on Sunday, we will talk about what Job learned.


