

Reflections From Pastor Tom



Dear Friends, This Sunday, I will be preaching on Luke 3:7-16 and my title will be "Prove It."

Every year in the Advent season, we get a "visit" from a special character. No, I'm not talking about Santa Claus. It's John the Baptist and we don't look forward to him but we get him anyway. We get him because he is an essential part of the Advent/Christmas story. He is the prelude and yet more than a prelude.

John came with a multi-faceted goal. He was there to call people to repentance, to baptize, to hold the religious and political leaders accountable for their sins, and to tell the people the Messiah was coming. He delivered his message in a strange, counter-cultural manner. When the crowds asked him "What, then, should we do?" he told them to live by a higher righteousness. He wanted them to live morally, and treat others fairly. His manner might have been rough and startling but his message was actually quite reasonable.

What will we do in this season to prepare for the coming of the Messiah? We should use this Advent season as if we were among the crowds hearing John's proclamation. We'll talk about that on Sunday. I hope to see you there.
