

Dear Friends,

This Sunday is the 4th and final Sunday of Advent. We will have two new members join and two children baptized. We will have the special Gift For Christ offering at the close of the service. I will be preaching on Luke 1:39-45 and my title will be "Blessed Is She Who Believes."

This passage is about Mary's visit to Elizabeth. Both are pregnant. Mary will give birth to Jesus

and Elizabeth will give birth to John the Baptist. Neither of them were likely candidates for motherhood. Elizabeth was beyond what might be considered child-bearing age and Mary - well, you know why SHE was unlikely to be expecting a child. They have more in common than unexpected pregnancy. They have incredible faith.

We can follow their example in our own lives. We can believe where we have not seen. We can show strength and determination when the odds are against us. We have our own surprises in life. Unexpected things happen. We will talk on Sunday about Mary and Elizabeth, faith and trust. I look forward to seeing you there.

The collection of non-perishable food items is an ongoing mission opportunity. Collection baskets are in the lobby each Sunday. Food donations can also be dropped off at the church office from 8:00 a.m. - 1:00 p.m., Monday - Thursday.
