What we are left with may not be everything we want, but it does include the most important claim - Jesus rose from the dead. That is the Easter message. That's what we need to know, what we need to hear, what we need to share.

The Easter message is always good news. It is always full of hope, and always meant for us. I hope you can be with us for our Easter celebration worship on Sunday. Christ is risen! He is risen indeed!


