

#### **Reflections From Pastor Tom**



Dear Friends, This Sunday, I will be preaching on Acts 4:5-12, and my title will be "The Trouble With The Truth."

At first thought, telling the truth should not be difficult. Say what you know for sure. DON'T say anything you can't be sure about. Yet from our earliest attempts at communication (not only as a witness in a

trial) we are faced with a troubling choice - do we tell "the whole truth, nothing but the truth so help me, God"? All of our communication relies on people telling the truth to each other but we have lots of excuses for not telling the truth (not hurting other people's feelings, protecting others from unfair criticism, not wanting to incriminate ourselves, etc.).

Early Christians boldly told the truth about Jesus - who he was, his teachings, and his death and resurrection. It cost them dearly. In the Scripture for Sunday, Peter spoke his beliefs before the Jewish authorities and it was a huge risk. They had already been imprisoned, but they could have been subjected to torture or they could have been executed. Peter spoke the truth anyway. That is an inspiration to us. We will discuss truth-telling in the sermon on Sunday.

#### Proctors-

- -MUST be 18 years or older and an approved CMS volunteer
- -May not be assigned to proctor in a room where a relative is testing
- -Read proctor guide
- -Receive face-to-face proctor training
- -May not assist students nor be left alone with testing materials
- -May not read test directions
- -Must turn off cell phone and not have access to any electronic devices.
