Reflections From Pastor Tom



Dear Friends,

This Sunday I will be preaching on John 3:14-21 and my title will be "Seeing in the Dark."

John the Gospel writer wrote poetry with his version of the life and ministry of Jesus. One of his prominent images is light/darkness. The setup for this week's lesson: Nicodemus, a Pharisee and scholar, came to talk to Jesus at night. The most obvious reason for his timing was that he didn't want to be seen talking to

Jesus. His Pharisee colleagues didn't approve of Jesus and they certainly wouldn't want one of their own questioning Jesus as if Jesus possessed any knowledge that they did not.

We notice as their conversation goes along that light and darkness does not just refer to the time of day. Jesus was in the light. He was "enlightened" in a way that Nicodemus was not. Nicodemus was living and thinking in darkness. He didn't understand what Jesus was talking about and misunderstood almost everything Jesus tried to explain to him.

We sometimes struggle to understand what Jesus is saying to us. Like Nicodemus, we are in the dark trying to see the light. We will talk more about this in the sermon on Sunday.

- -May not assist students nor be left alone with testing materials
- -May not read test directions
- -Must turn off cell phone and not have access to any electronic devices.




