Dear Friends, This Sunday, we will have communion and I will be preaching on Acts 10:44-48. My title will be "When The Church Changed Its Mind."

It is a proven fact that human beings change their minds. We do it all the time. When institutions, like the Church, change their minds, it is a significant event. That's because institutions are made up of groups of people and getting groups of

people to agree to change is much more difficult.

The Church has changed its mind throughout its history. Chapter 10 of Acts describes one of the earliest changes the Church made. Although the Church started as an exclusively Jewish movement, non-Jews (Gentiles) showed interest immediately. Peter led the Church in being open to ALL people, not only Jews. This was a controversial move, because many Christian Jews wanted the Church to remain only for people who were Jews first. Nevertheless, the Church became a religion for anyone and everyone who sought to follow Jesus. In the sermon on Sunday, we will talk about many more times the Church changed its mind and the implications for us today. I hope to see you there, but if not, I hope you can join us on the livestream.

May 28th will be the reading test; May 30th will be the math test and June 4th will be the 8<sup>th</sup> grade science test! Testing times are from 7:45am-12:00pm for all days.

#### Proctors-

- -MUST be 18 years or older and an approved CMS volunteer
- -May not be assigned to proctor in a room where a relative is testing
- -Read proctor quide
- -Receive face-to-face proctor training
- -May not assist students nor be left alone with testing materials
- -May not read test directions
- -Must turn off cell phone and not have access to any electronic devices.


