Reflections From Pastor Tom



Dear Friends, This Sunday I will be preaching on Mark 6:7-13 and my title will be "Time To Move On."

Transitions are hard. It doesn't matter whether you are moving out or moving in, changing jobs within the same field or changing fields altogether, retiring or working your first job, or

learning to drive or giving up driving - it is always challenging. Transition anxiety is real and we all experience it at one time or another in our lives.

Jesus experienced the anxiety of transition. He returned to his hometown after having achieved some notoriety elsewhere. It didn't go well. Jesus "was amazed at their unbelief." Next, Jesus instructed his disciples before sending them out to teach and to heal. Part of those instructions included what to do if you are treated badly or not received well in a certain place. Move on. Don't keep trying to convince people who clearly don't want to be convinced. We will talk about this advice on Sunday.






