Bob Dylan wrote a song in 1979 entitled, "*Gotta Serve Somebody*". What do you think he meant, and do you agree? Why or why not?

Many of us call Jesus our "Lord and Savior". Have you ever considered the difference between "Lord" and "Savior"? Take a few minutes to reflect on the meaning and the difference between the two. Write down your ideas. How do you identify with Jesus as "Lord"? ...as "Savior"?

Notice Jesus' instructions to his disciples when sending them to bring the donkey (Mark 11:2-3). Would you have found it easy to comply with Jesus' request? Why or why not? Notice how the people responded (verses 4-6). Why do you think the people were so willing to let them take the donkey?

After Jesus turned the tables and drove the merchants from the temple courts (Mark 11:15-19), Mark says the religious leaders wanted to kill Jesus. Why would that be? Mark says it was Jesus' amazing teachings. If Mark is right, why would they want to kill an amazing teacher?

Do you consider Jesus as "King" of your life? If so, what does that mean to you?
