Dear Friends, This Sunday, I will be preaching on 2 Corinthians 4:5-10 and my title will be "Treasure in Clay Pots."

Our world contains many treasures. From rare metals to natural wonders, or the creativity of human beings, some of the treasures of the world are readily observable. Other treasures are sometimes more difficult to discover. When the Apostle Paul wrote about "this treasure in clay jars," he was referring to the power of God within us. We are the clay jars, or clay pots. We are fallible, delicate, and

temporary containers of God's power. Nevertheless we have been entrusted with this treasure.

We should find this message both reassuring and unsettling. Whenever we are given something valuable, it is both a great honor and a significant responsibility. So it is with the power of God. We can let it work through us, surrendering ourselves to what God wants, or we can try to resist and be less cooperative. And also, sometimes, we can be confused about what God wants us to do. We will talk about this treasure on Sunday in worship. I look forward to seeing you there.


