all about what will happen next.

Like all of us, Abram didn't know what the future would bring for him. God told him about what was going to happen - Abram was going to be the father of a great nation and he would go to a land he had never seen previously. This would have come as a huge surprise to Abram. He had no children at that time and he had only known his country of origin. Even with all that he did not know, Abram believed what God had told him.

On Sunday, we will talk about preparing for the future, and what Abram's experience means for us. I hope to see you at church.

The Symbols of Lent



Purple was considered the color of royalty and wealth in the ancient world. It was an expensive and lengthy process to make it. The dye came from mollusk (shellfish), and they could get only about one drop out of each mollusk. We remember that Jesus was King of Kings, so purple is an appropriate color for us to use to remember him. We also know that many people mocked Jesus, calling him king as a cruel joke.

All courses will be held at University City UMC, 3835 W W.T. Harris Blvd., Charlotte - (You MUST attend all ten hours to receive credit for the course.)




