Reflections From Pastor Tom



Dear Friends,

This Sunday I will be preaching on Acts 11:12-18 and my title will be "Opening Up." We will have two High School graduates honored. We will also have a baptism and receive two new members.

Many people see the church (and all organized religion) as slow to change. I think that's a fair assessment. The church is a large entity with many groups and divisions. Those different groups frequently disagree with each other. Within these groups, there are also disagreements.

When people can't agree within their divided groups and between the groups, change will always come slowly, if at all. That's not making excuses. It's simply the truth.

The early church had similar problems. It was much smaller and geographically limited, yet from the beginning, the people struggled to agree on important issues. In this week's Scripture, Peter made a significant and controversial move - he opened the church to non-Jews. On Sunday, I will talk about the importance of this change and how it helps us understand our decisions today, both as a church and as individual Christians. I look forward to seeing you in worship.
