Reflections From Pastor Tom



Dear Friends,

On Sunday, we will celebrate Holy Communion and there will be a special Children's Time in worship. I will be preaching on Acts 9:1-9 and my title will be "In An Instant."

We are told that sometimes, life moves fast. We know it's true. Life moved fast for a guy named Saul of Tarsus. He was a Pharisee, devoted to the Law, and devoted to persecuting any

"enemies" of the Law. The first Christians, known as "The People of The Way," were seen by Paul and others as enemies of the Law, enemies of the Jewish faith, and therefore, enemies of God. In a quick and dramatic turnaround in his life, Saul went from being a persecutor of Jesus-people to being one of them. That wasn't all - Saul (soon to be referred to as "Paul") became a LEADER among Christians. That, too, happened quite rapidly.

Life moves fast, but not usually THAT fast. Those changes were challenging for Paul, and for the others around him. Christian leaders had to deal with this guy. They had feared him and now they were asked to accept him and follow him. In this sermon, we will talk about quick changes in life and how we should handle them. I look forward to seeing you in worship!
