Dear Friends, This Sunday I will be preaching on Acts 9:36-43 and my title will be will be "What Others Might Not See."

In my teaching and preaching, I often talk about mystery. I think it is important for people of faith to acknowledge that some aspects of our lives and our world are mysterious in that we cannot have "logical" explanations for

everything that happens. If we accept that God is at work in the world and in our lives, then we must also accept that we will not be able to comprehend or explain everything that we experience.

In the Book of Acts, we find many stories of miracles and wonders. This week we will look at a resurrection story. Peter was called upon to visit a community where a woman named Tabitha had died. She was well known for her good works and her faithfulness to Jesus. Peter arrived and went in to see Tabitha's body and he brought her back to life. Peter was not Jesus. Peter was only human, like you and me, but the Holy Spirit worked through him to allow him to do extraordinary tasks. He had a power beyond what anyone could see. In the sermon on Sunday, we will talk about this power and how it is applies in our lives.


