Dear Friends,

This Sunday, June 15, we will celebrate Pentecost, even though Pentecost was actually on June 8. Since I was out of town for the real date of Pentecost, I am preaching on Acts 2:1-8, 12-21 (the Pentecost story) on June 15. My title will be "Access." We will receive 3 new members in the worship service.

Pentecost is the birthday of the Church. When Jerusalem was filled with visitors who had come to celebrate the Jewish holy day of Pentecost, the Holy Spirit swept

through and empowered the disciples to speak in other languages. They began telling God's message and the people who spoke those other languages could understand what they were saying. Then Peter explained what was happening. God wanted everyone, no matter where they came from or what language they spoke, to hear and understand what the disciples were saying.

God is still communicating with us and we can understand. God finds ways to communicate with us even when there are challenges and barriers. That's how the church began and that's how God has continued to reach people. In this week's sermon we will talk about God's access to us and our access to God. I look forward to seeing you at church.
